The Great War

SPRING LUNCH & LAUNCH OF 2015 CALENDAR OF EVENTS - Sunday 8th March, 2015

Our Guest Speaker was Mr. Ger Lynch, Chairman, Mountmellick World War I, Research & Commemoration Group. In a very comprehensive address, Ger outlined why and how the Members of the Mountmellick World War I Committee and the Mountmellick Development Association (MDA) came together - to research the town's connection to WW1, and with the primary aims of establishing the number of soldiers from the townsland who served in WWI; the number of those who died in the war; to compile information on each individual and establish records in as far as is possible; to acknowledge those who fought in this horrendous war; and to commemorate and honour the memory of these men.

Among the results of the work by the WW1 Group, a museum housing records and memorabilia has been established in the MDA complex; a monument with a list of those who fought and died was erected at the Library: a year moving ecumenical

those who fought and died was erected at the Library; a very moving ecumenical service (attended by representatives of the Irish Defence Forces and the British Legion) to commemorate all those who served in World War I was hosted in St Joseph's Church by Fr. Michael Murphy, PP, and a very impressive remembrance concert was also held. In January 2015, the WWI Group won a Laois County Council Community Service Award. The Group has also produced a very impressive 3 x DVD Box Set - a considerable number of which were purchased by Association members on the day. Following the address, one of the DVDs was shown - a very moving documentary film illustrating the work, the events and the emotions engendered, particularly for the local families who lost loved ones in WW1.

Chairman, Gerry Thompson presented a cheque on behalf of the Association to support the ongoing research work by WW1 Group.


